



Plan To Re-Open Aim High Academy - North

All participants will be required to have a signed COVID-19 waiver from a parent or legal guardian in addition to our general waiver.

In the case of severe weather, we will most likely close. There is no way to enforce social distancing if we are forced to take cover.

All parents need to make sure all personal information and student medical histories are updated and current in the parent portal.

Stage One (Begins May 15, 2020) Main campus only

Competitive Team Only

- Our staff will continue to put new content on our YouTube channel each week for all of our classes (gymnastics, dance & ninja).

Scheduling / Class Ratio

- Team practices will be staggered to prevent gathering of large groups.
- We will implement 6' social distancing upon arrival, in the lobby and throughout the gym.

Arriving

- Parents must drop off athletes at the front door.
- Athletes should not arrive at practice earlier than 10 minutes prior to practice time (They should remain in cars if they arrive earlier).
- Athletes should not come to practice if they are not feeling well or have a sick family member.
- Athletes will enter through our front doors into the breezeway where their temperature will be taken by Aim High staff member. They will then proceed to a sanitizing station inside the door to the lobby.

Viewing

- Both the lobby and the observation room will be closed to prevent social gathering.
- Only staff and athletes may enter the building.
- We are looking into technology which will allow parents viewing on their phones or tablets.

Personal Belongings

- All athletes will arrive wearing shoes (slides or flip flops are encouraged).
- All athletes must bring their own personal mask to wear, a personal water bottle with their name on it as well as their hand grips (if they have them).
- No snacks should be brought to practice.
- If a gymnast uses a spray bottle on their grips, each gymnast must bring her own bottle with her name on it. It must be filled with water upon arrival - the water fountain will be off limits.

Restrooms / Locker Room

- The locker room will be off limits for gathering and will only be used as a restroom.
- Athletes must wear shoes into the restrooms.
- All restrooms will be used one person at a time.
- Correct hand washing (20 sec) must be done before returning to the gym.

Sanitizing

- Everyone will sanitize upon arriving and leaving the facility.
- Athletes will sanitize each time they rotate to a new apparatus in the gym.

Cleaning / Disinfecting

- We have purchased a mister and an approved COVID-19 cleaner. We will disinfect the gyms, lobby and bathrooms daily.
- An Aim High staff member will be present at each practice to sanitize equipment once a team group leaves an apparatus.

Exiting

- When practice is over, parents of team athletes should pick up at the west doors.
- Under supervision, athletes will sanitize and will then exit the building through the side doors to eliminate congestion in the breezeway and lobby when new groups arrive.
- Athletes should be picked up from practice on-time to help aid our flow of getting children in and out of the gym safely.

Staff

- All coaches will wear masks.
- Spotting will only occur if interference is necessary to prevent an injury.
- Aim High staff members will also be screened for temperatures.
- Staff will sanitize each time the students are asked to sanitize.
- No high fives, fist bumps or hugs will be given to students by coaches.
- Staff will not report to the gym if they knowingly have come into contact with an infected person or have had possible exposure to COVID-19.

Equipment

- Higher level athletes will be given a zip-lock bag containing chalk. It will have the gymnast's name on the bag. They must not share their chalk with anyone. There will not be any chalk stations.
- Any extra equipment used by athletes (bands, weights, hula hoops, etc.) will be placed in a sanitizing bucket and cleaned by a staff member before being used again.
- To enforce social distancing, more stations will be set up in the gym for the athletes.
- An Aim High staff member will be present at each practice to sanitize equipment once a team group leaves an apparatus.

Education / Guidelines

- Informative Signs and posters will be placed throughout the facility reminding athletes about social distancing, hand washing, DAB your cough/sneeze, etc.
- Parents will be updated via e-mail. Please be sure all e-mail addresses on file are current.

Stage Two (Begins June 1, 2020) North Campus

Girls Gymnastics Classes Age 6 & up and Ninja Classes

- Our staff will continue to put new content on our YouTube channel each week for all of our Toddler, Pre-school & Kinder classes.

Scheduling / Class Ratio

- Classes will be at their normal days/times.
- We will implement 6' social distancing in the lobby (upon arrival) and throughout the gym.

Arriving

- Parents must drop off athletes at the front door.
- Please have them use the restroom at home before they arrive.
- Athletes should arrive 10 minutes prior to practice time but not earlier than 10 minutes. (They should remain in cars if they arrive earlier). We feel it will take about 10 minutes for kids to get their temperature taken and sanitize before entering into the gym safely.
- We will require children to stand on marked locations (6' apart) and wait their turn to enter.
- Athletes should not come to practice if they are not feeling well or have a sick family member.
- Athletes will wait on social distancing spots and then enter through the designated door into the lobby where their temperature will be taken by Aim High staff member. They will then proceed to a sanitizing station in the lobby. This will all be monitored by your Aim High staff. They will be given an opportunity to use the bathroom at this time.
- If an athlete arrives late and there is no longer a staff member at the door, please call 918-794-4774 and wait for someone to help you. Athletes cannot enter without having their temperature taken by a staff member.

Viewing

- Only staff and athletes may enter the building.
- We are looking into technology which will allow parents viewing on their phones or tablets.

All Classes & Team

- We will consider continuing to have our staff put new content on our YouTube channel monthly for all of our classes (gymnastics, dance & ninja).

Scheduling / Class Ratio

- Classes will be at their normal days/times.
- We will implement 6' social distancing in the lobby (upon arrival) and throughout the gym.

Arriving

- Toddler, Pre-school and Kinder athletes will be dropped off at the designated door.
- Please have them use the restroom at home before they arrive.
- Athletes should arrive 10 minutes prior to practice time but not earlier than 10 minutes. (They should remain in cars if they arrive earlier). We feel it will take about 10 minutes for kids to get their temperature taken and sanitize before entering into the gym safely.
- We will require children to stand on marked locations (6' apart) and wait their turn to enter.
- Athletes should not come to practice if they are not feeling well or have a sick family member.
- Children will wait on social distancing spots and then enter through our designated door into the lobby where their temperature will be taken by Aim High staff member. They will then proceed to a sanitizing station in the lobby. This will all be monitored by your Aim High staff. They will be given an opportunity to use the bathroom at this time.
- If an athlete arrives late and there is no longer a staff member at the door, please call 918-794-4774 and wait for someone to help you. Athletes cannot enter without having their temperature taken by a staff member.
